A funeral service for Harold Eugene “Gene” Smith, 88 of Newark will be 1:00 p.m. Thursday, January 19, 2017 at Hanover Presbyterian Church, 732 N. Main St., NE, Newark with Rev. Charlsie Ramsey officiating. Burial will be in Hanover Cemetery. A luncheon at the church will follow the committal service.

Mr. Smith died Saturday, January 14, 2017 at Sharon Brooke. He was born May 20, 1928 in Lewisville, OH to the late Euclid and Geneva (Cree) Smith. He served his country honorably in the U. S. Army and worked for National Gas & Oil.
