N Ellen Merriam, 76, of Adamsville, Ohio died Sunday afternoon, January 1, 2017 at Genesis Morrison House in Zanesville, Ohio.

Born March 12, 1940 in Adamsville she was a daughter of the late Robert H. and Lena (Mersing) Hutchison and was a 1958 graduate of Adamsville High School. Mrs. Merriam was a realtor with Town & Country Realtors of Zanesville and she assisted in the operation of her family's business, Merriam Roofing of Adamsville.
