## **Donald Dean Kinzy**

**D**onald Dean Kinzy, 78, of Zanesville, formerly of Frazeytsburg passed away Sunday evening, November 13, 2016 at Genesis Hospital in Zanesville.

Born July 21, 1938 in Beallsville, Ohio he was a son of the late Carl V. and Wilma (Pittman) Kinzy and was a 1956 graduate of Beallsville High School. He was a member of the Church of Christ and attended Zane Trace Church of Christ. He was a farmer, growing up on a farm in Monroe County. Later he worked for many years in the oil fields. He also worked for Coshocton Memorials Monument Company for 37 years as well as being caretaker of Frazeytsburg Cemetery for many years. Donald was a former member of the Frazeytsburg Village Council and was instrumental in the construction of the Frazeytsburg Swimming Pool. After retirement he began helping his daughter and son in-law on the Briggs Family Farm in Zanesville. Mr. Kinzy spent many years researching his family genealogy and was a member of the Monroe County Genealogy Society and the Monroe County Historical Society. His love for God and his family was immense. He enjoyed spending time with his grandsons, and later in life, his great grandchildren.

Surviving is his wife of nearly 55 years, Darla (Brownfield) Kinzy whom he married December 27, 1961; a daughter and son in-law, Deanna and Randy Briggs of Zanesville; two grandsons, Mark Briggs and his wife, Aubrey and Michael Briggs and his wife, Chelsie; his great grandchildren, Luke Ryan Briggs, Lillie Elizabeth Kinzy Briggs, Ellie Anne Briggs and, unborn, Marshall Timothy Briggs, who is to be born in December. Also surviving is a sister, Janet Murray; a brother in-law, Dale Brownfield and his wife, Lorna; his uncle, Joe Pittman and his wife Barbara; and several nieces, nephews and many cousins.
