Charles E. Lentz, 81, of Frazeyburg, Ohio died Thursday morning, September 8, 2016 at Genesis Hospital in Zanesville, Ohio.

Born May 8, 1935 in Frazeyburg he was a son of the late Francis A. and Esther Mae (Ewan) Lentz and was a 1953 graduate of Frazeyburg High School. Mr. Lentz retired from Alltel Communications with over 30 years of service. He was a member of Frazeyburg United Methodist Church and was very active in all church activities. Charles loved working with his hands. He was accomplished at wood carving and he enjoyed carpentry and other building projects. He was an avid hunter, fisherman and outdoorsman. His keen sense of humor was an enjoyment to all.

Surviving is his loving wife of 60 years, Darlene R.
