Charles F. Peach, 70, of Newcomerstown, Ohio died Friday evening, May 6, 2016 at the Cleveland Clinic in Cleveland, Ohio.

Born March 7, 1946 in Glouster, Ohio he was a son of the late Kenneth and Edith (Dillon) Miller and was a 1964 graduate of Frazeyburg High School. He was a truck driver for over 40 years, driving for multiple companies in that span of time. Most recently he drove for Hanby Farms of Nashport, where he retired in 2013. Charles was a very avid sports fan. Rarely did he miss a Cleveland Indians game on TV and was always frustrated by the Cleveland Browns.
