Leona Untied Johnson, 83, of Zanesville, Ohio died Wednesday, April 27, 2016 in the emergency room of Genesis Hospital in Zanesville.

Born August 18, 1932 in Frazeytsburg, Ohio she was a daughter of the late Wilbur “Baily” and Velma (Baughman) Untied. Leona was a graduate of Frazeytsburg High School and the Bethesda School of Nursing. She was a registered nurse and worked in the Labor and Delivery unit of Bethesda Hospital for many years. She loved cooking, gardening and fishing and made many trips to Canada to fish.

Surviving are two brothers, Virgil (Sandy) Untied of Zanesville and Arthur (Ruth) Untied of Dresden; a sister, Esther Freshwater of West Lafayette, Ohio and several nieces and nephews.
