Wanda M. Field, 68, of Frazeyburg, Ohio passed away Wednesday morning, December 23, 2015 at her home following a progressive illness.

Born March 22, 1947 in East Peoria, Illinois, she was a daughter of the late James F. and Ruth L. (Sherrill) Osborn and was a 1965 graduate of East Peoria High School. She attended Illinois State University and Bradley University and received her Master's degree in education. She retired from teaching in Slidell, Louisiana after 30 years of teaching at various locations and states. She enjoyed working with children very much and spending time her family and friends.
