**A** graveside funeral service for Harold G. Carlson, Sr., 95 of Newark will be held Thursday, November 5, 2015 at 1:00 p.m. in Newark Memorial Gardens with Pastor Jeff Perry officiating.

Mr. Carlson died Saturday October 31, 2015 at the Flint Ridge Nursing and Rehabilitation Center. He was born April 19, 1920 in Hammond, Indiana to Emil and Edith (Ambros) Carlson.

He was raised in the Chicago area and moved to Newark in 1952 from Rochester, MN. He retired in 1985 with 33 years of service from Rockwell International as a foreman in the tool grinding department. He was a member of UAW # 1037. He was an active member of Faith United Methodist Church. He was a lifelong bowler and at the age of 78 bowled a 706 series.
