Harry B. "Sonny" Null, Jr., 78, of Toboso, Ohio died Thursday evening, October 1, 2015 at St. Ann's Hospital in Westerville, Ohio.

Born February 11, 1937 in Holland, Ohio he was the son of the late Harry B. Null, Sr. and Stella M. (Rayoum) Null. He was a member of the Toboso United Methodist Church.
