A funeral service for Francis "Frank" S. Xavier Janks, 97 of Port Charlotte, FL and formerly Hebron will be held Saturday June 27, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. in the Newark Chapel of Vensil & Chute Funeral Home with Deacon Patrick Wilson as celebrant. Burial will follow in Newark Memorial Gardens with military services conducted by the Licking County Veterans Alliance.

Mr. Janks died Sunday, June 21, 2015 at the Port Charlotte Hospice House. He was born December 2, 1917 in Pittsburgh, PA to the late Walter and Joanna (Tomkiewicz) Jankiewicz.

Mr. Janks retired in 1982 from Kaiser Aluminum as a fabricator with 30 years of service. He was a member of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Catholic Church of Buckeye Lake, United Steelworkers Union, and Hebron Historical Association. He served in the U.S. Army during WWII. He was a member of the Moose Lodge, BPOE and American Legion Posts in both Ohio and Florida. His past times included golf, gardening and was an accomplished cook.
