# Raymond D. Barton

JUL 16, 1950 - JUN 1, 2015

**R**aymond D. Barton, 64 of Johnstown died Monday June 1, 2015 at the Mt. Carmel Medical Center, West in Columbus, Ohio.

He was born July 16, 1950 in Newark to the late Howard Lewis and Anna Bernadine (Buck) Barton.

Mr. Barton was employed for 45 years with Krogers at their Heath and New Albany stores as a night stock clerk. He was a member of United Food and Commercial Workers Local # 1059.
