A funeral service for John Fred Schilling, 92 of Newark will be held Saturday March 7, 2015 at 1:00 p.m. in the Newark Chapel of Vensil & Chute Funeral Home with Rev. Ray Sunkel officiating. Burial will be in Eden Cemetery with military honors provided by the Licking County Veterans Alliance.

Mr. Schilling died Thursday, March 5, 2015 at his residence. He was born September 29, 1922 in Newark to Rushie "Dutch" and Marie (Frye) Schilling.

Mr. Schilling was employed as a truck driver for Pure Oil for 18 years. He also worked in the oil fields as a tool dresser. He enjoyed hunting, fishing and OSU Football. He had a long time interest in antique cars. He served in the Pacific Theatre during WWII in the U. S. Navy.
