Sandra Kay Fannin, 74, of Dresden, Ohio died Tuesday morning, October 21, 2014 at Willow Haven Nursing Home in Zanesville, Ohio.

Born September 3, 1940 in Dresden she was a daughter of the late Frederick and Ruby (Lutz) Swope and she attended Dresden Jefferson High School. Sandy was one of the Longaberger Company's original employees and she retired in 2004 from the guest relations department. She had previously been plant manager.
