## **Mazie Gertrude Taylor**

**M**azie Gertrude Taylor, 90, of Adamsville, Ohio passed into her Lord's loving arms Thursday evening, October 2, 2014 at Beckett House, New Concord, Ohio, after a short illness.

Born June 22, 1924 in Hopewell Township of Muskingum County, she was a daughter of the late Clyde and Glenna (Shiplett) Westcott and was a 1942 graduate of Hopewell High School. Following High School she attended and graduated from the Meredith Business College of Zanesville. Mazie retired from the Muskingum County Auditor's Office with 20 years of service and was later a home health aide with Interim Health Care. She was a 60 year member of the Order of the Eastern Star, first with the Frank M. Ransbottom Chapter in Adamsville where she served as Worthy Matron in 1981 and 1985, and then the Laura Chapter at Norwich, Ohio. Mazie was an active member of the Adamsville United Methodist Church, a member of the Daughter's of the American Revolution, as well as many varied activities and organizations over the years. She had an active life, loving gardening, especially her Iris and Day Lilies, traveling and driving her many friends to see new adventures.
