A funeral service for Earl R. Weber, 89 of Newark will be held Thursday, August 14, 2014 at 1:00 p.m. in the Newark Chapel of Vensil & Chute Funeral Home with Pastor William Wayt officiating. Burial will be in Newark Memorial Gardens with military honors conducted by the Licking County Veterans Alliance.

Mr. Weber died Saturday, August 9, 2014 at the Flint Ridge Nursing and Rehabilitation Center. He was born the youngest of nine children on May 22, 1925 in Lewisville, OH to David and Clara (Yoho) Weber.

Mr. Weber retired as a carpenter from Mason & Isabelle Construction Company in Columbus. He was a member of the Carpenters Union Local # 136.
