## **Max D. Ivers**

**A** funeral service for Max D. Ivers, 82 of Newark will be held Saturday June 7, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. in the sanctuary of Marne United Methodist Church, 1019 Licking Valley Road NE with Pastor Ben Foulk officiating. Entombment will follow at Cedar Hill Cemetery. Military honors will be conducted by the Licking County Veterans Alliance.

Mr. Ivers died Wednesday June 4, 2014 at the home of his daughter. He was born January 7, 1932 in Perry County to the late Faye and Mary Elizabeth (Frazier) Ivers.

Mr. Ivers was a 1949 graduate of Newark High School. He served in the U. S. Navy and Navy Reserve during the Korean Conflict. He had been employed by Smythe Manufacturing, a technician for Green's Radiator, Newark Stove and retired in 1992 from Rockwell Manufacturing. He served two terms as chief union steward for Local # 1037 UAW. A member of American Legion Post # 85, Newark Loyal Order of Moose, Newark Eagles and Marne United Methodist Church. He enjoyed bowling and was active in several different leagues. He was a coach for several years at the Mound City Little League. He was an avid Cleveland Indians fan. He spent many enjoyable hours outdoors hunting and gardening. He lived and loved for his family. His greatest accomplishment was passing his values and integrity to his children.
