Richard A. "Dick" McCune, 72, of Newark, Ohio died Wednesday morning, April 9, 2014 at Selma Markowitz Care Center in Newark.

Born July 19, 1941 in Coshocton, Ohio he was a son of the late Edward and Nannie (Craig) McCune and was a 1960 graduate of Newcomerstown High School. Dick was very proud to be an American and he honorably served his country during the Viet Nam War serving in the 101st Airborne Division of the United State Army. He was employed for many years with the Kroger Company, working at the Heath, Ohio store for the last 20 years. He was a member of the Lutheran Church of Newcomerstown, the American Legion Post #85 of Newark and he was an avid outdoorsman, enjoying hunting and fishing.

Surviving is his wife, Faye R.
