Elma A. Graham, 96, of Frazzeysburg, Ohio died Tuesday morning, April 8, 2014 at Genesis Morrison House Hospice in Zanesville, Ohio. Mrs. Graham was a homemaker and a life member of Mt. Pleasant Christian Church and a 70 year plus member of the Ladies Missionary Society. In later years she attended Perry Chapel Baptist Church.
