A funeral service for George L. Myers, 86 of Croton will be 10:00 a.m. Saturday, April 5, 2014 in the Newark Chapel of Vensil & Chute Funeral Home with Rev. Scott Schieber and Rev. Torie Front officiating. Burial will be in Frazeyburg Cemetery.

Mr. Myers died Tuesday at St. Ann Hospital, Westerville. He was born September 14, 1927 in Coshocton County to the late Lawrence and Sara "Millie" (Vermilion) Myers. A graduate of Union Local High School, Mr. Myers was a dedicated farmer. He was a member of the Ohio Dorset Breeders Association, the Farm Bureau Council #38, Land of Legend Antique Tractor Club, and a lifetime member of Licking County Sheep Improvement Committee. He was also a member of the Highwater Congregational United Church of Christ.
