**I**van N. Van Allen, 77 of Zanesville died Friday, February 21, 2014 at the Adams Lane Care Center. He was born August 17, 1936 in Frazeytsburg to the late James C. and Ethel M. (Cline) Van Allen.

He retired in 1992 from Rockwell Manufacturing in Heath with 35 years of service. He was stationed in Germany while serving in the U. S. Army. He was a member of UAW Local # 1037. He was a former member of the Frazeytsburg Presbyterian Church. He enjoyed farming throughout his lifetime and was a member of the Muskingum County Farm Bureau. He contributed to many veterans and health care causes, including DAV and Alzheimer's.
