A memorial mass will be celebrated for Terry D. Chute, 71 of Newark on Wednesday, February 12, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. at St. Edward The Confessor Catholic Church, 785 Newark- Granville Road, Granville with Monsignor Paul P. Enke, celebrant. Private burial will be in St. Patrick Cemetery, Junction City, Ohio.

Mr. Chute died Friday, February 7, 2014 at the Selma Markowitz Care Center operated by Hospice of Central Ohio. He was born May 11, 1942 in New Lexington, OH to the late Arthur and Martha (Murray) Chute.

For over 20 years he has been a partner in the Sentinel USA, Inc. He retired in 1991 from the Newark Air Force Base. He was a former Prudential Insurance agent.
