Ola Ellen Grimes, 93, of Nashport, Ohio passed away peacefully Wednesday evening, December 25, 2013 at Willow Haven Nursing Home in Zanesville. Born December 16, 1920 in Frazeyburg, Ohio she was a daughter of the late William and Elizabeth (Bowers) Untied and was a homemaker.

Ola was also the owner and operator of Willie's Café and Welcome Inn of Zanesville during the 60's and 70's. She lived in Florida for a while and travelled back and forth to visit family and friends.
