Irvin "Bill" Ray Ludwig

Irvin "Bill" Ray Ludwig, 90, of Frazeytsburg, Ohio died Thursday evening, September 5, 2013 at his home.

Born May 5, 1923 in Woodsfield, Ohio he was a son of the late William and Garnet (Swartzlander) Ludwig. Mr. Ludwig was an Army veteran of World War II and was in the European theatre. He retired in June of 1985 from Buckeye Pipeline/Ohio Oil Gatherings where he was superintendent of the Macksburg Division. He retired with 38 years and 9 months of service with the company. Mr. Ludwig was a member of the Frazeytsburg United Methodist Church; Wakatomika Post # 6193, VFW of Frazeytsburg and Frazeytsburg Lodge #490, F & AM. He enjoyed woodworking and building grandfather clocks. He also enjoyed gardening, golf, bird watching, especially Purple Martins, and was a very avid Ohio State Football fan.

Surviving is his loving wife of 66 years, Ida Belle (Schultheis) Ludwig whom he married August 16, 1947; two daughters, Carolyn (Don) Kniesly of Pleasant City, Ohio and Janet (Timothy) Archer of Laurelville, Ohio; two sons, Stanley (Nina) Ludwig of Frazeytsburg and Dean (Jackie) Ludwig of Belpre, Ohio; 13 grandchildren; 29 great grandchildren; two sisters, Jane Ludwig and Loretta Mann, both of Delaware, Ohio and several nieces and nephews.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his step-mother, Helen Ludwig; a brother, William Ludwig and a sister, Doris Jeffers.
