Edwin C. Chaney, 83 of Frazeytsburg, died Monday evening, July 22, 2013 at Select Specialty Hospital in Zanesville.

Ed was born May 28, 1930 in Coshocton County to the late Emmett and Lizzie (Rine) Chaney. He operated a magneto repair business from his home for many years and was an oil field worker. He had also worked for Fallsburg Supply, Buckeye Supply and the Licking County Highway Department. Ed was a member of the Mt. Pleasant Christian Church and a member of Wakatomika Lodge #108 F&AM where he was a Past Master.
