“**T**ogether Again” James O. Holdsworth, 86, of Coshocton, Ohio died Thursday evening, May 30, 2013 at Genesis Good Samaritan Hospital in Zanesville, Ohio.

Born November 23, 1926 in Coshocton County, Ohio he was a son of the late August and Nellie (Ramsey) Holdsworth. Mr. Holdsworth was a retired elevator superintendant from the Coshocton Grain Company. He was a member of the Dresden First Baptist Church and was the organizer of the Friday night “Gospel Sing” in the Dresden area churches.

Surviving are two sons, and daughters in-law, James Allen and Brenda Holdsworth of Coshocton and Jack Lee and Kathy Holdsworth of Newark, Ohio; four grandchildren, Lori (Larry) Monroy, Amy (Rich) Lawrence, Valerie Holdsworth and Bruce (Felicia) Holdsworth; eleven great grandchildren and one great grandchild. Also surviving is a sister, Gladys Dobson of Trinway, Ohio and several nieces and nephews.
