Virginia L. Longfellow, 88, of Nashport, Ohio died Tuesday morning, May 14, 2013 at the home of her son, Raymond Longfellow in Nashport.

Born August 13, 1924 in Newark, Ohio she was a daughter of the late Orville and Madura (Howard) Felumlee and was a graduate of Nashport High School. Mrs. Longfellow was a homemaker and a member of the Nashport United Methodist Church. She attended Meadowview Church of Christ in Frazeytsburg and was a former member of the Order of Eastern Star.
