Mary Ellen Moss, 89, of Frazeytsburg, Ohio died Tuesday afternoon, May 7, 2013 at Genesis Good Samaritan Hospital in Zanesville.

Born November 12, 1923 in Frazeytsburg she was a daughter of the late Charles and Edith (Shafer) McFarland and was a 1941 graduate of Frazeytsburg High School. Mary proudly served our country during World War II as a part of the United States Army Women's Army Corp (WAC). In 2009 she was inducted into the Muskingum County Veterans Hall of Fame, the first woman so honored. Mary was also the first woman elected to the Tri-Valley High School Board of Education and served for 12 years. She worked for 22 years in the office of the Ohio Plastics Company of Frazeytsburg and she assisted in the operation of Moss Trucking for many years with her husband and son. She was an avid CB'er and was known by many by her nickname and CB handle, "Bine".

Mary always was involved in her community. She was a volunteer at Frazeytsburg School for 15 years and was famous for the pies and cookies she baked for all events and fund raisers. Mary was a member of the Wakatomika Veterans Club and served as the secretary of the Frazeytsburg Alumni Association for many years. She was also active in the Frazeytsburg Boosters Club and served as treasurer of the Frazeytsburg-Nashport Youth League for 40 years.

Surviving is her son, Clinton L. "Bud" Moss; a sister Lois Robison; and a brother in-law, Larry Hindel, all of Frazeytsburg, along with several nieces and nephews.

In addition to her parents she was preceded in death by her husband, Virgil D. Moss whom she married June 28, 1941 and who died April 15, 1990; a son, Charles Moss and a sister, Elsie Howard.
