**W**anda V. Haines, 90, of Frazeytsburg, Ohio died Monday morning, May 6, 2013 at her home.

Born February 21, 1923 in Bucyrus, Ohio she was a daughter of the late Jacob E. Barger and Wanda B. (Moore) Lipsey Barger. She was a homemaker and she retired in 1986 from J. C. Penny's after 13 years of service. Wanda was a member of the Frazeytsburg Presbyterian Church and was a former member and past matron of both the Frazeytsburg and Dresden Order of Eastern Star. She was an avid and active animal lover.
