Wanda E. Gulley, 85, of Dresden, Ohio died Wednesday afternoon, April 10, 2013 at her home.

Born July 3, 1927 in Nelsonville, Ohio she was a daughter of the late Edward and Elizabeth (Parry) Bateman and was a 1945 graduate of Nelsonville High School. Mrs. Gulley was a homemaker and a member of the First Christian Church of Nelsonville. She was also a member of the Sorosis Literary Club of Dresden.
