A funeral service for Larry L. Williams, 66 of Johnstown will be 11:00 a.m. Thursday, April 4, 2013 in the Newark Chapel of Vensil & Chute Funeral Home. Military funeral honors will be provided by the Licking County Veterans Alliance.

Mr. Williams died Monday, April 1, 2013 at his residence. He was born July 18, 1946 in Columbus to the late Oretha Virginia (Carter) Williams and Virgil F. Williams of Somerset.

He retired from Lucent Technologies as a production associate with 34 years of service. He served in the U. S. Army during the Vietnam era.
