Vernon W. "V.W.P." Parsons, 71, of Dresden, Ohio died Sunday afternoon, March 31, 2013 at Brandon Regional Hospital in Brandon, Florida.

Born November 25, 1941 in Parkersburg, West Virginia he was a son of the late Wayne N. and Vallie D. (Nicholson) Parsons and was a 1960 graduate of Point Pleasant High School. He was owner and operator of MS. Parsons Construction and he retired in 1998 because of health reasons. Vernon was a member of the Main Street Church of Christ in McConnellsville, Ohio and a member of Dresden Lodge #103, F. & A. M. He was also a retired member of the Dresden Volunteer Fire Department. He loved working in his shop doing wood crafts and he enjoyed hunting and fishing with his grandchildren, rebuilding and working on his winter home in Florida and golfing. Surviving is his wife of nearly 52 years, Janet "Kay" (Calendine) Parsons whom he married June 3, 1961; three daughters and sons in-law, Kimberly K. and Rocky Brownfield of Nashport, Ohio, Kelly L. and Randy Wycinski of New Lexington, Ohio and Karen E. and Drake Prouty of Dresden; six grandchildren, Melissa Brownfield, Aaron Brownfield, Sydney Lapp, Dayne Prouty, Mitchell Wycinski and Jared Wycinski; two brothers, Clarence M. (Patricia) Parsons of Zanesville and Richard W. (Rita) Parsons of Dresden and several nieces and nephews.
