Marguerite “Jean” Lapp, 88, of Dresden, Ohio died Thursday morning, February 28, 2013 at Genesis Morrison House in Zanesville.

Born October 4, 1924 in Madison Township of Muskingum County, she was a daughter of the late Miles and Zetta (Crozier) Lane and was a 1942 graduate of Dresden Jefferson High School.
