A funeral service for Harold Lane, 82 of Heath will be held Thursday, January 31, 2013 at 11:00 a.m. in the sanctuary of the Church of God of Licking County, 2181 Riggs Road NE with Pastor Anthony Bartlette officiating. Burial will be in Newark Memorial Gardens with military honors by the Licking County Veteran Alliance.

Mr. Lane died Monday, January 28, 2013 at the Selma Markowitz Care Center. He was born December 24, 1930 in Arlington, W.Va. to the late Ford Simon and Armeda Mae (Haymond) Lane.

Mr. Lane retired with 30 years service as a machine operator at Rockwell Manufacturing. He also drove school bus for the Newark City Schools for an additional 8 years. He was a member of the Church of God of Licking County, Local #1037, He served in the U. S. Navy during the Korean Conflict. He enjoyed repairing and rebuilding small engines. He spent many hours gardening. He was well known for his poetry, music and artistic talent.
