Charles E. "Chuck" Wasson, 82, of Frazeytsburg, Ohio died Saturday evening, November 17, 2012 at Forest View Health Campus in Zanesville, Ohio. Born August 7, 1930 in Willard, Ohio he was a son of the late Ernest G. and Leona A. (Dean) Wasson Giles and was a veteran having served in the United States Navy. Mr. Wasson owned and operated the Gulf Service Station in Frazeytsburg for 27 years, retiring in 1983. He was a member of the Frazeytsburg United Methodist Church and a member and past president of Frazeytsburg Lions Club where he received the Melvin Jones Award in 1989-1990 and was Lion of the Year in 1995-1996. He was as a 50 year member of Frazeytsburg Lodge #490, F. & A. M., Wakatomika Veterans Club of Frazeytsburg, American Legion Post #888 of Delaware, Ohio, New-Ark Emmaus Community of Newark, Ohio and was a former member of the Order of Eastern Star, Frazeytsburg Jaycee's and the Frazeytsburg Volunteer Fire Department. Mr. Wasson received a Volunteer Award from Tri-Valley Schools for his 27 years of service as a crossing guard in Frazeytsburg.

The Wasson family would like to express a deep gratitude to the staff and "family" of Forest View Health Campus for the loving care and compassion extended to Chuck and his family.

Surviving is his wife of nearly 60 years, Naomi J. (Power) Wasson whom he married December 7, 1952; one son, Eric (Dawn) Wasson of Nashport, Ohio; three daughters, Sarah L.
