Kathryn F. Longaberger, 97 of Dresden died September 26, 2012 at Autumn Healthcare of Coshocton. She was born December 22, 1914 in Bristol, PA to the late Clarence and Ellen (Bilger) Craig. From the age of eight she was raised by Frank and Kate Ogle. A 1933 graduate of Jefferson High School, Kate was a homemaker. She had worked part-time at the Dresden Branch Library and Jefferson High cafeteria. She was a member of the Dresden Presbyterian Church for 80 years. An avid gardener, Kate also enjoyed crafts and sewing. She made many pieced baby blankets and crocheted rag rugs. Survivors include her son, John (Joyce) Longaberger of Conesville; daughter, Ellen Andrews of Dresden; grandchildren, Melody (Ken) Lowe, Renee (Pat) Anderson, Jim (Hope) Longaberger, Jeff (Jodi) Haines, all of Coshocton, John (Debbie) Haines of Wills Creek, Julie (Bob) Niswonger of Bristow, VA., and Carrie Barnes of Zanesville; and many great-grandchildren and great-great-grandchildren.
