Eleanor L. Longstreth, 88, of Dresden, Ohio died Thursday evening, August 2, 2012 at Genesis Good Samaritan Hospital in Zanesville.

Born November 21, 1923 in Coshocton County, Ohio she was a daughter of the late Harvey and Mildred (Smailes) Phillips and was a 1941 graduate of Dresden Jefferson High School. She was also a graduate of Meredeth Business College of Zanesville. She worked at the Bush Woolen Mill in Dresden, the Trinway Post Office and was a cook at Jefferson Elementary School until her retirement in 1992. Mrs. Longstreth was a member of the Trinway United Methodist Church and a former member of the Order of Eastern Star.
