Mrs. McDonnell died Tuesday July 3, 2012 at her residence. She was born June 20, 1914 in Mt. Vernon, Ohio to the late Clement and Carol “Bessie” Hope Baker Ghiloni.

Mrs. McDonnell was a member of The Church of the Blessed Sacrament. She was owner of the 400 Shoppe and Do-Lots Craft Center. She was a member of the Land of Legends Decorative Painters and The Pythian Sisters. She had attended St. Vincent Academy in St. Vincent, Ky.
