**A** Mass of Christian Burial for Leo M. Fink, 64 of Rushville will be 11:00 a.m. Tuesday, May 15, 2012 at Holy Trinity Catholic Church, 228 S. Columbus St., Somerset, Ohio with Father Jordan Turano, O.P., celebrant. Burial will be in Holy Trinity Cemetery. Military funeral honors will be conducted by the Leo Ryan Post 58 of the American Legion.

Mr. Fink died Thursday May 10, 2012 at the Fairfield Medical Center. He was born February 7, 1948 in New Lexington to the late Stanley and Anna Mae Fink.

A 1966 graduate of St. Aloysius High School in New Lexington, Mr. Fink was employed for the past 24 years as a technician with the Boeing Company in Heath. He served honorably in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam Era. He was a member of the American Legion, Leo Ryan Post 58 in Somerset and Holy Trinity Church. He enjoyed hunting and fishing. Leo spent many hours working in his vegetable garden. His family was the most important blessing in his life.
