A graveside service for Nancy A. Evans, 81 of Newark will be held Thursday, May 10, 2012 at 11:00 a.m. at Cedar Hill Cemetery with Rev. Charlie Smith officiating.

Mrs. Evans died May 2, 2012 at her residence. She was born September 15, 1930 in Tiffin, Ohio to the late Franklyn J. and Mary Virginia (Walk) Gahris.

Mrs. Evans was a member of Second Presbyterian Church. She was a past Deacon and honored recently for 50 years membership. She volunteered at the church food pantry and served as a Team Captain. Mrs. Evans was a graduate of Heidelberg College. Mrs. Evans taught school for over 30 years. She retired from the Cherry Valley Elementary School.
