## **Eloise M. Tilton**

MAR 26, 1910 - JAN 7, 2012

**E**loise M. Tilton, 101, of Frazeytsburg, Ohio died Saturday afternoon, January 7, 2012 at the Helen Purcell Home in Zanesville, Ohio.

Born March 26, 1910 in Columbia City, Indiana she was the daughter of the late Benjamin and Luella (Huffman) Meitzler and was a 1927 graduate of Lake View High School in Chicago, Illinois. Mrs. Tilton was a member of the Frazeytsburg Presbyterian Church and the Quest Circle of the church and was the treasurer of the church building fund for many years. She was also a member of Olive Branch Chapter #251, Order of Eastern Star of Duncan Falls, Ohio; Frazeytsburg "51" Club; Frazeytsburg Review Club; and the "Monday Afternoon" card club. Very active in volunteering, she volunteered at Good Samaritan Medical Center of eleven years and was a member of the Licking County Medical Auxiliary. She enjoyed sewing, knitting, baking and playing her baby grand piano.

Surviving are four daughters, Nancy Forker of Zanesville, Judith Kimball of Rock Island, Illinois, Margot (Peggy) (David) Wright of Frazeytsburg and Betsy (Jake) Adams of Beaverton, Oregon; nine grandchildren, Sean Lapp, Eric Lapp, Keith Kimball, Mark Kimball, David Wright, Michael Wright, Denise Wright, Jennie Adams and Josh Adams and seventeen great grandchildren.

In addition to her parents she was preceded in death by her husband of nearly 60 years, Dr. Louis J. Tilton whom she married April 18, 1931 and who died January 9, 1991; a brother DeWitt Meitzler and a grandson, Brian Jon Wright.
