A funeral service for Robert W. Shrivvers, 64 of Nashport will be 1:00 p.m. Monday December 5, 2011. in the Newark Chapel of Vensil & Chute Funeral Home with Pastor Tom Myers officiating. Burial will be in Hanover Cemetery.

Mr. Shrivvers died Thursday December 1, 2011 at Licking Memorial Hospital. He was born December 21, 1946 in Licking County to Robert Cecil and Bonnie Jean (Andrews) Shrivvers. Mr. Shrivvers retired in 1986 from Rockwell International where he had worked for 20 years. Together with his wife Mr. Shrivvers owned and operated Hanover Pizza and Ice Cream since 1982.
