Donald G. Hindel, 83, of Frazeytsburg, Ohio died Sunday morning, November 20, 2011 at Genesis Good Samaritan Hospital in Zanesville, Ohio.

Born September 12, 1928 in Dresden, Ohio he was the son of the late Joseph D. and Mary E. (Luckett) Hindel. Mr. Hindel was a veteran of the Korean War serving in the U. S. Navy and was a 2011 inductee into the Muskingum County Veterans Hall of Fame. He was a member of the Frazeytsburg United Methodist Church, a member and Past Commander of Wakatomika Post #6193, VFW of Frazeytsburg, Frazeytsburg Veterans Club and the Muskingum County Veterans Council. Mr. Hindel was also active in the Masons as a Past Master of Frazeytsburg Lodge #490, F. & A. M.; Past High Priest of Muskingum Chapter R. A. M.; Past Illustrious Master of Zanesville Council R. & S. M.; Past Commander of Zanesville Cyrene Commandery, Knights Templar and was a Knight of the York Cross of Honour; a member of the Ancient and Accepted Order of Scottish Rite, Valley of Cambridge and the Knights Masons of Dublin, Ireland #62.

Surviving is his wife of 54 years, Carol M. (Freshwater) Hindel whom he married September 7, 1957; three sons, Delroy D. (Michele) Hindel and Donald E. Hindel, both of Frazeytsburg and Jack J. (Kendra) Hindel of Dresden; two brothers, Larry L. Hindel of Frazeytsburg and James F. (June) Hindel of Myrtle Beach, South Carolina; a sister, Mary K. Smith of Frazeytsburg; seven grandchildren, Caylee, Caitlin and Caroline Hindel, Elizabeth Hindel and her fiancée, Steven Ward, Jacob, Kaleb and Gage Hindel and several nieces and nephews.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by five brothers, William, Leland, John, Dorsey and Jack Hindel and two sisters, Anna Slaughter and Loretta Groves.
