DRESDEN – Lance Alan Cody, 41, of Dresden, Ohio died Tuesday morning, October 18, 2011 at Riverside Methodist Hospital, Columbus, Ohio.

Born December 21, 1969 in Zanesville, Ohio he is the son of the late Larry J. Cody and Judy M. (Graves) Cody of Dresden and was a 1988 graduate of Tri-Valley High School. Mr. Cody was a warehouse manager at Myers Wholesale in Newark, Ohio. He was an avid outdoorsman and enjoyed hunting, fishing and spending time with his sons.
