NEWARK: A funeral service for Eugene D. Vandebusch, 82 of Newark will be 11:00 a.m. Saturday, August 13, 2011 in the Newark Chapel of Vensil-Orr & Chute Funeral Home with Pastor Ralph Gordon officiating. Burial will be in Smith Chapel Cemetery.

Mr. Vandebusch died Monday, August 8, 2011 at Licking Memorial Hospital. He was born June 10, 1929 in Thornville to the late Octaaf J. and Deva F. (Starkey) Vandebusch. A 1947 graduate of Glenford High School, Mr. Vandebusch served honorably in the U.S. Air Force during the Korean Conflict. He retired from Rockwell International. Mr. Vandebusch was a member of Second Baptist Church, the American Legion, V.F.W., Sportsman Clubs, and Moose Lodge.
