FRAZEYSBURG – Wava E. Norman, 92, of Frazeytsburg, Ohio died Tuesday morning, July 26 at Genesis Morrison House, Zanesville, Ohio.

Born August 25, 1918 in Belle Valley, Noble County, Ohio she was the daughter of the late John W. and Olga G. (Marquis) McCutcheon and was a homemaker. Mrs. Norman was a member of the Frazeytsburg Presbyterian Church and was a well-known quilter. She enjoyed sitting on her front porch with her best friend, the late Grace Johnston, and visiting with friends.

Surviving is a sister in-law, Opal Gould of Dresden and a brother in-law and sister in-law, Bob and Eva Norman of Frazeytsburg and several nieces, nephews and great nieces and great nephews.

In addition to her parents she was preceded in death by her husband, Homer Norman whom she married August 24, 1940 and who died June 22, 1981; a brother Carlos E. McCutcheon and a sister, Juanita L. Price.
