A graveside funeral service for Bonnie L. (Haycook) Dunn, 82 of Newark will be 11:00 a.m. Friday, July 15, 2011 at Cedar Hill Cemetery with Rev. Mark Katrick officiating.

Mrs. Dunn died Tuesday morning, July 12, 2011 at Kingston of Ashland in Ashland, Ohio after a long battle with Parkinson's Disease. She was born March 8, 1929 in Newark to the late Gerald and Hazel (Devereaux) Haycook. A 1947 graduate of Newark High School Mrs. Dunn had worked for the Newark Telephone Company, Newark City Schools and retired in 1991 from Ohio Bureau of Employment Services.
