FRAZEYSBURG – Ronald L. “Duck” Hardesty, Sr., 66, of Hopewell, Ohio died Tuesday evening, July 12, 2011 in the emergency room of Genesis Good Samaritan Hospital, Zanesville, Ohio.

Born September 10, 1944 in Zanesville, Ohio he was the son of the late Donald L. and Margarite J. (Connolly) Hardesty. He was a 1963 graduate of Frazeyburg High School and was member of the Army National Guard for 20 years. He was a retired from the maintenance department of Rockwell International and was a member of the Rockwell Retirees Club.
