**F**RAZEYSBURG – Marvin Laverne Jungling, Sr., 49, of Frazeytsburg, Ohio died Saturday afternoon June 4, 2011 in the emergency room of Genesis Good Samaritan Hospital, Zanesville, Ohio.

Born February 17, 1962 in Zanesville, he was the son of the late Frank E. Jungling and Gladys J. (Lake) Jungling McFarland of Frazeytsburg. Mr. Jungling was a self-employed farmer and was an avid outdoorsman and enjoyed hunting. He was a member of the Ohio Big Buck Club and the Boone and Crockett Club.
