## **Dora Mae Middlemus**

**F**RAZEYSBURG – Dora Mae Middlemus, 78, of Lancaster, Ohio died Sunday morning, May 15, 2011 at Crestview Skilled Nursing Center in Lancaster. Born April 21, 1933 in Frazeytsburg, Ohio she was the daughter of the late Asher and Emily Jane (Minnich) Kerr. Following the death of her mother, Dora was raised from age nine by the late Addison and Helen Morgan. She was a 1951 graduate of Frazeytsburg High School. Mrs. Middlemus was a member of the Fairfield Community Church of Lancaster and was employed for nearly forty years at Bay's Food Market on Maple Street in Lancaster. She had also worked in the customer service department of Metropolitan Life Insurance Company.
