## James "Jim" Lacy

JUN 7, 1920 - MAY 1, 2011

**F**RAZEYSBURG – James E. “Jim” Lacy, 90, of Nashport, Ohio died Sunday evening, May 1, 2011 at Cedar Hill Care Center, Zanesville, Ohio.

Born June 7, 1920 in Dresden, Ohio he was the son of the late Edwin and Leona (Ridgeway) Lacy and was a 1939 graduate of Jefferson High School. Mr. Lacy was a veteran of World War II serving in the Pacific Theater with the U. S. Army. He retired in 1977 from Armco Steel Corporation of Zanesville. He also was a farmer and sawmill operator in Nashport for many years.
